# Free Credit Report

The Fair and Accurate Credit Transactions Act (FACTA) entitles consumers to one free credit report from each of the three nationwide consumer reporting companies.

You may request your annual credit report through a Web site, by phone, \or by mail. You must provide your name, date of birth, social security number, and current and previous address (if you have moved within the past two years).
